Taylor Cultural Arts Commission By-laws

The Taylor Cultural Arts Commission is established by the Taylor City Council in order to provide education, promotion and greater understanding of the cultural arts in the City of Taylor.

- The Taylor Cultural Arts Commission shall be created by the Taylor City Council by formal resolution.
- The Taylor Cultural Arts Commission shall consist of seven (7) members recommended by the Mayor and confirmed by the Taylor City Council.
- Commissioner terms shall be for a period of one (1) year beginning on January 1st and expiring on December 31st.
- Commissioners shall serve unpaid.
- The Taylor Cultural Arts Commission shall operate under the jurisdiction of the Parks and Recreation Department and shall work with the assistance of the Executive Director or his or her designee in an advisory capacity only.
- Meeting dates for the following year shall be set by the commission at their last regularly scheduled meeting of the year.
- The initial meeting schedule shall be established at the organizational meeting of the Taylor Cultural Arts Commission.
- The commission shall select from among its members a chairperson, a vice-chairperson and a secretary/treasurer. No member may serve more than two consecutive terms in the same office.
- Election of officers shall occur at the first regularly scheduled meeting of the year.
- The Taylor Cultural Arts Commission shall not have a separate operating budget.
- With approval of the Executive Director of Parks and Recreation, the Taylor Cultural Arts Commission shall have the right to amend the bylaws with a majority vote by its members.
