Long Description (Accessible Description for Screen Readers)

This map presents a broader, citywide view of Taylor, Michigan, showing a dense network of streets organized primarily in a grid pattern with some irregular subdivisions.

Major transportation routes are clearly visible:

- Interstate 94 (I-94) runs diagonally across the southern portion of the map.
- Telegraph Road runs north–south along the eastern side.
- Other major corridors such as Eureka Road and Goddard Road run east–west across the city, connecting neighborhoods and commercial areas.

Ecorse Creek is visible as a winding waterway running generally west to east through the northern half of the city, serving as a natural geographic feature.

Numerous parks and green spaces are distributed across the map, including:

- Heritage Park, a large recreational area in the southeastern section
- Northwest Park in the northwestern area
- Additional smaller neighborhood parks scattered throughout
